Additional Notes for Cruise Ships:

Reservation Fee: 10% of the harbor dues upon booking.

Guarantee: Berth availability is guaranteed ("weather permitted") after payment.

Cancellation Policy:

If cancelled within 365 days of the planned date without prior written notice → reservation fee is non-refundable.

Rescheduling within the same calendar year → no extra reservation costs, provided the new date does not conflict with existing bookings.

Cancellation within one week before arrival → 100% of harbor dues will be charged.

In case of **force majeure** or **extreme weather** preventing safe mooring → reservation fees will be refunded.

Note: Zeehaven IJmuiden N.V. reserves the right to adjust tariffs due to developments in the harbor and to change or cancel berths due to weather conditions and/or congestion.
